The director at large would be responsible to support us in our mission and activities, and the term of the position is 2 years.

In addition to nominations, what else is likely to be on the agenda?

- Outcomes from our September meeting with the DNR, where we provided them with survey results of the Friends' membership, and discussed the future of the Stewart Tunnel (which is currently closed)
- Any information about the Savannah Master Plan
- We are considering a capital campaign to help fund trail maintenance, and an endowment fund to secure the future of the trails
- Trail pass sales with affiliates for 2020, and plans for 2021
- Possible volunteer activities
